Jon Phillips

Chief Executive Officer - Global Infrastructure Investor Association

Jon was appointed CEO in January 2023 having joined GIIA in 2016 to lead on communications strategy, public affairs and membership growth as Corporate Affairs Director and Deputy CEO.

Between 2005 and 2016 he was Communications Director for the Nuclear Decommissioning Authority, a UK government agency established to run the £3bn a year nuclear clean-up programme.

Prior to that, Jon spent 12 years at airport operator BAA Heathrow, where he led the communications campaign for the £4.2bn T5 project.



Alina Osorio

President, Fiera Infrastructure

Alina Osorio is the President of Fiera Infrastructure. Since partnering with Fiera Capital in 2016 to form Fiera Infrastructure, Alina has presided over the firm's significant growth, expanding assets under management more than 15-fold. As President, she is responsible for setting strategic direction, overseeing investment strategies, executing acquisitions, and managing an infrastructure portfolio with over C\$4 billion in AUM. Alina is a seasoned investment professional in the infrastructure investment and financing sector. She has contributed to the evolution of the infrastructure asset class during her many years of experience from her roles initially as an equity research analyst covering Canadian utility companies, an investment banker in the infrastructure space, then a principal investor, and, finally, a portfolio strategist for a major Canadian pension fund. Alina has extensive experience and an established track record as a principal investor in infrastructure, including her role as the CEO of North America's first unlisted infrastructure fund focused in both Canada and the US, the Macquarie Essential Assets Partnership ("MEAP"). Thereafter Alina led the infrastructure program at OPTrust, with a capital allocation of C\$2.5 billion to the infrastructure strategy. Alina holds a Bachelor of Engineering from McGill University and an MBA from the Schulich School of Business at York University. She is also a Chartered Financial Analyst and a Professional Engineer in the Province of Ontario.



Lisa Mitchell

President and CEO, Canadian Council for Public-Private Partnerships

Lisa Mitchell is the President and CEO of the Canadian Council for Public-Private Partnerships, a national not-for-profit, member-based organization with broad representation from across the public and private P3 industry participants.

Lisa has 20 years of leadership, communications, and public affairs experience, including more than a decade advocating for and



advancing P3s, most recently as Senior Director, Investments, Partnerships and Innovation at Infrastructure Canada. Prior to that Lisa was Director, Strategy and Market Development at PPP Canada Inc., where she led the strategic planning and corporate reporting functions as well as policy and communications for the Crown corporation.

As an advocate for Canada's P3 model and market, Lisa has led extensive research initiatives on the model to position Canada as a global leader. She is a recognized thought leader in Canada and internationally and is the former Chair the Organization of Economic Cooperation and Development's (OECD) Senior Infrastructure of PPP Officials Network.

Lincoln Webb

Executive Vice President and Global Head of Infrastructure & Renewable Resource Investments, BCI

Lincoln Webb joined BCI in March 2002. He leads the firm's infrastructure & renewable resources group, which manages a growing private market portfolio of \$28.1 billion – with investments across 30 countries and all major infrastructure sectors. BCI is a multi-asset class investment organization with \$250.4 billion of gross assets under management as of March 31, 2024. Headquartered in Victoria, British Columbia and supported by industry-leading expertise, BCI is one of Canada's largest institutional investors.



Prior to his current role, he was Global Head of BCI's private equity program – building an extensive portfolio invested across developed and emerging markets. As a member of the firm's executive management team, management investment committee, talent committee, and investment risk committee, Lincoln is also engaged in setting strategic direction and overall management of BCI.

Lincoln holds an MBA in international Business, MCP in architecture, CFA designation, and an Advanced Management Designation from INSEAD. He is also a past attendee of management programs at HHL, in Germany, and Harvard Business School.

Lincoln chairs the presidential and supervisory Boards of Open Grid Europe, Germany's largest gas transmission utility, and serves on the boards of Czech Grid Holdings, Viterra, Mosaic Forest Management, as well as Endeavour Energy and the Costa Group in Australia. He is also a Director of the boards of the Global Infrastructure Investor Association, and the Pacific Pension & Investment Institute.
